

Healthwatch Northumberland Board decisions and action points 24 March 2020

The Healthwatch Northumberland Board was due to meet on 24 March 2020. Due to the COVID19 outbreak the meeting could not go ahead. - 10. Strategic Risk Register to add additional current and future risks

Members agreed to add a specific risk addressing business continuity for COVID19. They noted the measures already enacted by Adapt North East and the Healthwatch Northumberland operational team to enable the service to keep going. The revised register will be circulated for the next meeting.

Other agenda items

Members were also supportive of taking forward in principle work with one Primary Care Network to help establish a Patient Participation Group.
