Healthcare Travel Costs Scheme

If you are referred to hospital or other NHS premises for specialist NHS treatment or diagnostic tests by a doctor, dentist or another health professional, you may be able to claim a refund of reasonable travel costs if you are on a low income or in receipt of benefits. For more information call 0300 330 1343.



Help with prescription costs

Some people are entitled to free prescriptions due to their age, income or if they have certain disabilities or health conditions. The Government has a five-minute online survey that will let you know if you can get free NHS prescriptions, dental treatment and eye tests.



People on a low income may get financial help with prescription, dental, eye care and healthcare travel costs (see above) plus wigs and fabric support costs. Call the NHS help with costs helpline: 0300 330 1343.
